

CUMULATIVE RECORDS

a.k.a.

CR

Cumulative records are full of information about your students. These files contain:

- Demographics
- Past grades and test scores
- Important behavioral and psychological information
- Eligibility for educational services in the past and present
- S-Team, M-Team, IEP, Misc. Records
 - S-Team: A meeting to determine a plan of action for a student experiencing academic and behavioral difficulties. (Parent not necessarily present)
 - M-Team: A meeting for special education students to evaluate services (IEP) and discuss academic issues. (Parent always present)
 - IEP: Individualized Education Plan

THE INFORMATION CONTAINED IN CR's IS CONFIDENTIAL

You are encouraged to look through your students' CR's as soon as possible. CR's should be reviewed before parent conferences. It is helpful to know a student's background in order to prepare appropriate plans of action.

At the end of the year, you will be required to report all students' grades in their CR's. This is made very easy using pre-printed labels. If TCAP scores are available, those labels must be added as well.

** CR's are located in the student office. They are arranged by grade, in alphabetical order. **
